ADHD Referrals

We are getting a lot of requests for adult ADHD referrals. Please be aware that all of these requests have to go through our CCG panel and despite some people using the 'Right to Choose' forms, you cannot go straight through to ADHD 360. This is for all referrals from ages 16 onwards. If you are able to be seen then the CCG will direct your referral one of 3 ways and to the way most appropriate for your needs. The surgery cannot make direct referrals to ADHD 360 on your behalf as funding needs to be approved.
